

Vicious Dogs Prohibited (7-5-140)

It is unlawful to keep, possess or harbor a vicious dog with the town.



Certain Animals Prohibited (7-5-70)

It is unlawful to keep any of the following animals within the Town of Platteville: hogs, pigs, goats, sheep, buffalo, deer, elk, cattle, horse, fowl (includes roosters) and geese.



Keeping of Chickens (7-5-75)

A resident may keep 6 chickens (hens) on their property, after obtaining a permit and complying with all the permit requirements.



Cat Vaccinations (7-5-160)

Any person who acquires a cat shall have it vaccinated against rabies within 30 days.

The Platteville Police Department does not have any other cat codes and does not respond to stray cats or any other cat related problems.

Dead Animal Removal (7-2-30)

It is the duty of the owner or keeper of an animal that has died, to remove it from their property and dispose of it in accordance with state laws.



Platteville Municipal Code Information

The owner, keeper, harbinger or person responsible for a dog, is anyone who permanently owns a dog or has temporary responsibility for its safety, care and well being. No person in Platteville shall have more than (3) dogs at their residence, that are (6) months or older.



Dog Running at Large (7-5-130)

A dog shall be considered running loose if it is not on the premises of the owner or on a leash (10) feet long or less and in the immediate control of the owner. All dogs found running loose will be caught by police and brought to the Platteville kennel. If the owner does not claim the dog within (3) days, it will be taken to the Weld County Humane Society located at 1620 42nd Street, Evans, Colorado 80620. You may contact them at (970) 506-9550.

License Required (7-5-200)

All owners of a dog that is (6) months or older are required to purchase a Town of Platteville dog license each year, before March 31st. of each new year.



Attachment of Tag to Collar (7-5-260)

All owners of a dog are required to place a collar or harness on it, and attach the town of Platteville license to it.

Rabies Vaccination Required (7-5-230)

All dogs shall be vaccinated against rabies and the vaccination shall be kept current. Current rabies tags shall be attached to dog's collar or harness.



Barking Dogs (7-5-150)

No owner of a dog shall allow it to bark, yelp or howl in a manner that is annoying to neighbors.

Removal of Fecal Matter (7-5-180)

Any person who takes a dog to any property in town, shall immediately remove all feces left on the ground by the dog.



Cruelty to Animals (7-5-110)

It is unlawful to mistreat, neglect, abandon or needlessly kill an animal. All animals must have adequate shelter, food and water.
