Materials NOT Accepted:

- Pesticides
- Paint
- Small Propane Tanks
- Aerosol Cans
- Tires
- Electronics (TVs, DVD Players, Stereos, etc.)
- Freezers
- Refrigerators
- Air Conditioners
- Loose Dirt
- Some Construction Materials

Burning within town limits is not allowed without a burn permit from Weld County.
