FACILITY REOPEN PLAN



July 1, 2020

Town Hall

- Regular hours of operation Monday – Friday from 8:00am – 4:30pm.
- Customers are limited to ten (10) persons inside the building at a time with physical distancing maintained.
- Facial coverings are strongly recommended and anyone exhibiting signs of illness will be required to leave the building.
- Customers must check-in at the front desk upon entering. Public restrooms are open.

Senior Center

- The Recreation/Senior Director and Coordinator will work regular hours Monday-Friday. No regular public access, appointment only.
- Starting May 12th the Center will be open on Tuesdays and Thursdays each week from 9:00am-11:00 & 1:00pm-3:00pm. A maximum of ten (10) senior members are allowed at any given time with prior appointment.
- Starting June 8th, Monday & Friday Nutrition Meals will be a pickup “grab-n-go” with limited delivery as requested.
- Tuesday evening Nutrition Meals are scheduled from May 19th through August 11th. Pick-up & delivery only.
- All attendees must wash hands upon entering and leaving the Center and maintain physical distancing.
- Activity trips remain cancelled until further notice.

Community Center / Ball Fields / Public Parks

- The Community center may be rented at a maximum capacity of fifty (50) attendees.
- Weekly recreation sponsored activities are permitted at a maximum of fifty (50) attendees.
- Municipal Court will be held at the Community Center through July with enforced physical distancing, facial coverings and temperature checks. The Senior Center and Fitness Room will be closed during the afternoons on court dates.
- The Fitness Room is open but restricted to ten (10) users at a time. A keyless entry system has been installed so please contact Town Hall to purchase a membership and keyless entry card.
- The ball fields are open but restricted to use of one hundred and seventy five (175) or less participants at any given time. Restrooms are open for use during rentals.
- The majority of youth activities will be based upon “at-home” activities provided by the Director and Coordinator. Summer baseball and softball leagues have been cancelled but other youth activities are being scheduled. Please contact the Recreation/Senior Director for additional information.
- Lincoln, Riverview, Coronado and Rogers Farm Parks are open to the public.
- Parks shelter rentals are allowed for groups of fifty (50) or less. Portable restrooms at Lincoln and Riverview Parks will remain open and cleaned regularly.

Platteville & Nantes Libraries

- Both libraries are open to the public with limited hours. Other events are being offered online along with "on your own" activities.
 - Limited public access with staff in buildings and face coverings strongly encouraged.
 - Limit of ten (10) patrons at a time at Platteville and five (5) patrons at Nantes with fifteen (15) minute visits.
 - At risk adults 10:00am – Noon and closed from Noon to 1:00pm for disinfecting.
 - Open 1:00pm – 5:00pm for general public. Social distancing required at all times.
- The High Plains Library District will continue abiding by State and Weld County Health Department guidelines and adjusting accordingly.

Museum

- The museum may open on Monday's & Wednesday's from 9:00am-4:00pm at the discretion of the Platteville Historical Society.

Cemetery & Veterans Memorial

- The Mizpah Cemetery and Veterans Memorial is open daily to the public from 5:00am-10:00pm.
- Physical distancing and facial coverings are encouraged for funerals and ceremonies with a maximum of 175 attendees.

Platteville/Gilcrest Fire Protection District

- The new fire station is now open to the public with the following guidelines:
 - Regular hours of operation Monday – Friday from 8:00am – 5:00 pm.
 - Customers may only access the front desk at the counter.
 - No member of the public will be allowed past the front counter unless by appointment and approved by a Department Head.
 - No meetings with over 10 attendees will be allowed including public meetings and District or Staff meetings.
 - Facial coverings are recommended but not required if physical distancing is maintained.
 - Employees are encouraged not to share items such as phones and other desk equipment and personal items.
- If you are experiencing an emergency situation, please call 911 rather than coming directly to the fire station.
